CONVICTION FACTOR	MANDATORY BAN	EXPLANATION
<u>PERSONS SUBJECT TO A LIFETIME REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT UNDER A STATE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION PROGRAM</u>	PERMANENT BAN	AFTER convicted person is no longer subject to the lifetime registration requirement.
<u>PERSONS CONVICTED OF THE MANUFACTURE OF METHAMPHETAMINE ON THE PREMISES OF FEDERALLY ASSISTED HOUSING</u>	PERMANENT BAN	
<u>VIOLENT BEHAVIOR, CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES OR ALCOHOL RELATED OFFENSES</u> <u>CLASS A , B, or C FELONIES</u> <u>CLASS D or E FELONIES</u>	6 YEARS 5 YEARS	AFTER convicted person has served his/her sentence (not including parole or probation), and has no further convictions pending charges.
<u>CLASS A MISDEMEANORS</u> <u>CLASS B OR UNCLASSIFIED MISDEMEANORS</u>	4 YEARS 3 YEARS	AFTER convicted person has served his/her sentence (not including parole or probation), and has no further convictions pending charges.
<u>MULTIPLE CONVICTIONS</u>	LONGEST APPLICABLE PERIOD
