CONVICTION FACTOR	MANDATORY BAN	EXPLANATION
PERSONS SUBJECT TO A LIFETIME REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT UNDER A STATE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION PROGRAM	PERMANENT BAN	UNTIL THE CONVICTED PERSON IS NO LONGER SUBJECT TO THE LIFETIME REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT.
PERSONS CONVICTED OF THE MANUFACTURE OF METHAMPHETAMINE ON THE PREMISES OF FEDERALLY ASSISTED HOUSING	PERMANENT BAN	
<u>FELONIES</u> CLASS A, B, or C CLASS D or E	6 YEARS 5 YEARS	AFTER convicted person has served his/her sentence (not including parole or probation), and has no further convictions or pending charges.
<u>MISDEMEANORS</u> CLASS A CLASS B or UNCLASSIFIED	4 YEARS 3 YEARS	AFTER convicted person has served his/her sentence (not including parole or probation), and has no further convictions or pending charges.
